

UIL SWIMMING AND DIVING OFFICIALS REGISTRATION FOR THE 2011 - 2012 SEASON

As has been previously communicated, registration and testing for Texas High School Officials will take place through UIL. Registration, testing and fee collection will be performed electronically through the UIL website. For those officials whose school districts pay their registration fees, reimbursement to you from your school district will be necessary.

The details are as follows:

• Swimming Officials:

- It will be necessary to complete the registration and two tests, the technical rules test and the compliance test.
- Regional clinics will be conducted as has been done in the past. During the course of the clinics, current year rule books will be distributed and any significant rule changes will be discussed.
- Registration will be available only through the UIL website. The path is as follows:

 - Navigate to Sports Officials (right hand corner of webpage)
 - Navigate to Registration and “click here to register”
 - Navigate to UIL Swimming and Diving Paid Membership.
 - Testing will be available only through the UIL website.
 - The path is as follows:
 - www.uiltexas.org
 - Navigate to Sports Officials
 - Navigate to Testing and select “Take Test” under “Open Tests”
- Information concerning the technical rules test:
- Tests will be available from 01 September 15 December 2011.
- The test questions will come up one at a time and there are 50 questions. The test questions and the answer choices will come up in random order each time you log onto the test. Passing will consist of answering 40 questions correctly, i. e., 80%.
- Results will be indicated immediately and you will be able to pull up the questions that were missed. If necessary it will be possible to take the test a maximum of 5 times to achieve a passing grade.
- If re-testing is necessary, you will have to take the entire test over again and the questions will come up in a different order than they did on your original test.
- It is possible to save and exit the test and then return to the same test. However, if your computer times out while you are taking the test or you simply log off without saving the test, the current test will be lost and you will have to start all over again.
- Once achieving 90%, it will not be possible to retake the test.
- The registration fee for 2011 is \$50.00

Diving Officials:

- The registration process will be identical to swimming officials, but the rule books will be distributed at the TISCA clinic in Austin being held from 09 September 11 September, 2011.
