

South Texas LSC Evaluator Criteria

In South Texas, we would like to encourage our more experienced officials to mentor other officials within the LSC through the National Evaluation process. In particular, we want to have officials in the LSC who are able to provide N2 evaluations for all positions as well as N3 Stroke and Turn evaluations. To that end, the Officials Committee has established the following criteria in order to be a LSC Evaluator:

- Must be a currently certified South Texas official (note that this does not preclude officials from outside of South Texas from being an evaluator).
- Must hold a current N3 certification in the position they wish to evaluate.
- Must have officiated at a TAGS, Zones, Sectionals, or higher-level meet within the past 5 years.
- Must be approved by the Officials Committee.

In order to act as an evaluator at a meet, the following requirements must be met:

- The prospective evaluator must have the endorsement of the Meet Referee.
- The meet must be an approved Officials Qualifying Meet (OQM) and the prospective evaluator's name must be listed on the OQM application.
- The evaluator must serve at all sessions of the meet.
