CPR and Safety Training for Swim Coaches

USA Swimming has a new approved vendor list for CPR and Safety training for Swim Coaches. They removed any vendors that do not do in person recertifications. The new list is posted on the USA swimming and South Texas websites

CPR and In-water safety training extensions:

CPR can be extended until 7/1/21 with an approved vendor online portion certificate. As of now the in-person portion of the certification needs to be completed by that date. This is only for certifications that expired during COIVD and is not an automatic extension. This is NOT an automatic extension. Online portion of the certificate needs to be emailed to the South Texas office.

In person portion of safety training for swim coaches has been extended until 7/1/21 with a valid online portion of the safety training for swim coaches' certificate. This is not automatic, and a valid online certificate needs to be emailed to the South Texas office.

Membership update

Flex membership will remain the same for the 2022 swim season.

Data from STAGS

STAGS 2020 was at TXLA, I pulled that meet for a comparison. STAGS 2020 used the "STAGS" time standards. STAGS 2021 used the "A" and faster time standards, which were across the board a bit faster in 2020, due to the new NAGS times. The STAGS meet was approximately the same size, across the three locations in 2020 and 2021. Total athletes 2020 – 734 and Total athletes 2021 – 702, Total splashes (prelims only, minus relays) 2020 – 2953 and Total splashes 2021 (no relay events) - 2631

STAGS 2020 @ TXLA

734 athletes

2953 prelims splashes (not including relays, which was 212 splashes)

56% best times overall (which would be prelims and finals combined, including relays)

STAGS 2021

Central @ ASC 275 athletes in 1131 splashes (48% best times) North @ AQTX 245 athletes in 882 splashes (39% best times) South @ SRG 182 athletes in 618 splashes (35% best times)
